ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and material necessary for the Dunkirk Harborfront Pier and Plaza Improvements Project will be received by the City of Dunkirk City Clerk at City Hall, 342 Central Avenue, Dunkirk, New York 14048 until 10:00 AM local time March 22, 2019 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids will be received for the following Contract:

Base Bid: Dunkirk Harborfront Pier and Plaza Improvements Project

The work under General Construction shall include all labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment, and other means of construction necessary and incidental to the completion of improvements shown in the Contract Drawings at the Pier in the City of Dunkirk and the intersection of Lakeshore Drive and Central Avenue in the City of Dunkirk. The construction includes, but is not limited to, demolition and removal, site work, excavation, backfill, grading, concrete site work, asphalt, curbing, signage and striping, accessible crosswalks, site furnishings, underground site utilities, lighting, and all other related items.

Add Alternate Bid Item No. 1: NYSDOT Intersection Improvements

The work under Additive Bid Item No. 1 shall include all labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment, and other means of construction necessary and incidental to the completion of the proposed improvements associated with the Central Avenue and Lakeshore Drive intersection. The work shall include all necessary demolition, removals, layout, curbing, pavement, traffic signal upgrades, accent treatments, and work zone traffic control specific to the intersection work, and as indicated on Contract Drawings sheet numbers S-001, S-101, L-001, L-101, L-102, L-200, L-201, and L-301. Additive Bid price shall include installation of all equipment, materials, and appurtenances associated with the elements in the intersection, and any mock-ups or shop drawings associated with.

Following registration, complete sets of Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the Issuing Office's website as "zipped" portable document format (PDF) files. The Issuing Office charges a non-refundable fee of \$49.00 (Forty Nine Dollars) to download documents. The date that the Bidding Documents are downloaded will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of the Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office.

Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his or her bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

A Pre-bid Conference with the City of Dunkirk will be held at City Hall, 342 Central Avenue, Dunkirk, NY 14048, on Thursday March 7, 2019 at 11:00 AM local time, in the Mayor's Conference Room. Although not mandatory, attendance by all those proposing to submit is highly recommended. Bidders may also inspect the work site, by appointment only, by contacting Rebecca Yanus, Director of Planning and Development at (716) 366-9879.

This is a tax exempt capital improvement project, and Bidders shall not include in their bid sales and compensating use taxes on the cost of materials which are to be incorporated into the work and which are to be separately sold by the Contractor to the City prior to incorporation into the work of the Contract.

The attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

The City requires contractors to utilize their best efforts to achieve goals for Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs) and Women's Business Enterprises (WBEs) participation in the form of labor or materials procurement on this project. For this project, the goals are a minimum participation of 30% by MWBE firms. The successful bidder will be required to take various affirmative steps to achieve the participation goals set forth herein as required under the New York State Empire State Development funding.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all Bids.
