

To whom it may concern from the City of Dunkirk, Town of Dunkirk, Town of Sheridan and the Village of Silver Creek:

On behalf of Score This!!!, I am requesting the use of the roads and facilities in your city or town in order to host our annual multisport event on August 25th, 2013 in the City of Dunkirk. The name of the event is "Tri Dunkirk" and it will be in a triathlon format that will include an open water swim, a bike race, and a running race. The race will take place on a Sunday and run approximately from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00pm.

This event in its third year should attract as many as 400 participants and many spectators. Last year's race attracted 300 participants in its second year. Score This!!! has been organizing multisport events since 1995 and hosted the 2011 and 2012 Tri Dunkirk in the City of Dunkirk. This area makes an excellent venue to host this style of event with athletes commenting on this being their new favorite venue. For the last five years, our triathlon races in Western New York have all sold out in advance of race day and we would expect to realize that potential with a race in Dunkirk within the next two years.

We are writing this letter in advance to work out all of the details for the course and to help all parties take advantage of this athletic tourism influx. Many triathletes travel beyond their state borders. Almost half of all triathletes surveyed (47 percent) say that they have traveled more than 500 miles to a triathlon which would include participants from as far away as the Syracuse and Albany regions of New York state as well as from surrounding cities like Cleveland of states like Ohio, Pennsylvania, Maryland, New Jersey, and Vermont.

Tri Dunkirk will surely increase visitation to Chautauqua County. Multisport athletes like to explore the areas they visit in many different ways. If they are provided the information about the surrounding areas activities they will return to explore this in the future. CONSENT TO APPOINTMENT OF FISCAL AFFAIRS OFFICER

WHEREAS, Section 2-10.02 of the City Code provides that the Fiscal Affairs Officer shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of the Common Council, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-10.02 of the City Code, Mayor Anthony J. Dolce has appointed Richard Halas, Dunkirk, New York, as an independent contractor, to the position of Fiscal Affairs Officer for the City of Dunkirk, subject to the consent of the Common Council, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Richard Halas, as an independent contractor to the City of Dunkirk, be confirmed as Fiscal Affairs Officer for the City of Dunkirk, effective January 7, 2013, at the rate of \$30,000.00 per annum for a minimum of twenty-five (25) hours per week.
