GENERAL NOTES

RUBBISH AND RECYCLABLE ITEMS should be at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection but no earlier than 7:30 p.m. the evening before. Containers should be covered tightly and should weigh **no more than 65 pounds**. Plastic bags should weigh **no more than 15 pounds**. Residents shall not mix hazardous materials, animal waste, yard waste, bulk materials, recyclables or other non-rubbish items with rubbish. City reserves the right to refuse collection of co-mingled materials or materials placed in unsuitable containers (ie. no handles, ripped bags, water-filled).

ZERO-SORT RECYCLING - Recyclable materials are collected curbside every other Monday with the exception of holidays - please see above calendar for dates. The ZERO-SORT program allows residents to place all recyclable materials in one container with no sorting necessary. Eligible items include cardboard, and boxes such as cereal, pasta, shoe, and non-food contaminated pizza boxes. Also plastic containers marked with the recycling numbers 1-7, glass containers of any color, and aluminum, tin and steel cans including pie plates, trays and foil. Residents may also bring recyclable items to the CITY RECYCLING CENTER on West Lucas Avenue between the hours of **7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. ONLY**, Monday through Saturday, except holidays. At times, the Center may be closed on Saturdays.

BULK ITEM DISPOSAL - Curbside collection will only be available during the months of April and August. Prepayment must be made at the Dunkirk City Clerk's Office at City Hall. Residents may also bring bulk items to the Public Works Facility on West Lucas Avenue after first prepaying at the City Clerk's Office. The Clerk can be contacted at 366-0453 for fees and scheduling.

BULK ITEM FEE SCHEDULE (subject to change):
Freon Items (Refrigerators, Freezers, AC units, etc.): \$25.00
Major Appliances (Washers, Dryers, Stoves, etc.) \$10.00 for the first item and \$5.00 for each additional item picked up at the same time.
Gas Grills \$10 without tank, \$15 with tank
Large Household Furnishings (ie. chairs, sofas, tables, beds, sinks, bathtubs, carpeting (must be bundled no longer than 4' with a diameter of no more than 18" or exceed 50 pounds)) \$10.00 for 1st item and \$5.00 each additional item picked up at the same time.
Tires (no rim) \$10.00 each, **Tires (with rim)** \$20.00 each
 TV's, computer peripherals and similar items are considered household hazardous materials and will have special disposal requirements.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIALS: Such as wood, plaster, drywall, etc. - No collection is available and should not be mixed with solid waste. Owner is responsible for disposal.

BRUSH COLLECTION NOTES: Brush will be picked up in the respective DISTRICTS as shown on the schedule above. **Brush must be at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on the Monday of the respective collection week but no earlier than the previous Saturday. City crews will collect each area only once.** Brush placed at the curb after the collection deadline will not be collected and will be ticketed as a violation of the City Code. **Brush should be bundled with string or twine and be no more than 4' long, diameters of no more than 18" and shall weigh no more than 65 pounds.** Bundles should be placed between the sidewalk and curb but should not be placed near any posts, trees, water or sewer boxes, etc. which could be damaged during removal operations. Brush placed on City property other than the area fronting the respective residential property will be ticketed.

CITY BARN BRUSH/YARD WASTE DROP-OFF AREA AND COMPOST AVAILABILITY: City residents may bring yard waste materials such as branches, leaves, grass, garden waste, etc. to the Public Works Facility for drop off. Please deposit materials in the correct locations for brush and compost. **DO NOT MIX.**

COMPOST MATERIALS: City residents may pick up compost/mulch and woodchips (when available) at the Street Department. Please call 366-4411 to schedule.

LEAF COLLECTION: Fall leaf collection will be scheduled as determined by the Public Works Department and will be advertised separately.

CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY HAZARDOUS WASTE DAYS: Chautauqua County offers free-of-charge hazardous waste drop-off days several times a year to County Residents.
