

Mayor Dolce,

My name is Greg Craft and I am one of the managers at Chautauqua Health & Fitness in the D & F Plaza. I am again interested in putting on our 5K road race called the "D & F 5K Challenge" at the beginning of the summer. Last year's race was even more successful than our first year! We had over 170 participants and over 15 sponsors. The community very much enjoyed the event, and with the help of the Dunkirk and Fredonia Police it went off without a hitch.

I would like to run this years event much like last year. This year I would like to have the race at 9:30am on Saturday June 21st. Like last year, I feel this is a good weekend when there is not any other activities going on in the community that would interfere. Additionally, a run at the end of June would not affect the attendance of any previously established races (Lakefront 5K, Tri-Dunkirk) which are scheduled for later in the summer. Enclosed is the official USA Track & Field map of last years course. It is quite expensive have the course officially mapped out, so I would like to keep the same route this year. I would like to start and end the race at the end of the D & F plaza by Middlesex Dr. This would offer ample room for a start line and finish shoot that would be off any road and safe for participants. This is also a lot of room for the runners to warm up and cool down, as well as a good area to set up a tent with tables, food, drinks, music, awards, etc. If the race is approved I will get a waiver of insurance from USA Track & Field stating Dunkirk, Fredonia, and SUNY Fredonia as additionally insured.

The only change I would like to make for 2014 is the addition of a 1 mile "Fun Run." A 5K (3.1 miles) can be a little too far for some young children, and senior citizens. By adding a shorter distance "race," I can allow more people to participate that might be intimidated by a full 5K. I would like to start this run at 9:00am, and have the participants start and end at the same point as the 5K race. Their route would only take them about 3/4 of the way down Birchwood, before turning around and returning to the plaza.

I am writing to you because I want to see if you can approve this race and help me with any roadblocks you might see necessary. I will also be contacting the chief of police of Fredonia and Dunkirk, SUNY Fredonia, and Mayor Keefe of Fredonia. Chautauqua Health & Fitness is going into its 7th year of operation and continuing this 5K is a great way to give back to the community. Other than what the college offers, Fredonia doesn't have any road races and I feel this was a nice addition to the wide array of events Fredonia offered last year. 

**ENCOURAGING CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY LEGISLATION
IN REGARD TO HYDRO-FRACKING**

WHEREAS, the wastewater that resurfaces from horizontal hydro-fracking operations and the brine that subsequently rises have been shown to have levels of bromine and radium hundreds of times that permitted by U.S. drinking water standards; and

WHEREAS, the brine has been shown to have concentrations of dissolved solids that may easily become toxic to aquatic life and damage water treatment equipment; and

WHEREAS, horizontal hydro-fracking in Marcellus shale may use three to eight million gallons of fresh water within a week, with 300,000 to 800,000 gallons of wastewater per well resurfacing during the following thirty days; and

WHEREAS, such wastewater and brine are already being transported through parts of Chautauqua County for disposal in disused vertically-drilled wells in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the current moratorium on horizontal hydro-fracking in New York State may be lifted in the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, pollution of water supplies in Chautauqua County would endanger our drinking water and all agricultural production and related industries and all tourism dependent on lakes and streams; and

WHEREAS, such pollution has already developed elsewhere as a result of failures in the production, transport and/or disposal of the wastewater and brine in question; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City of Dunkirk Common Council expresses support for County action to prevent damage to the water table, lakes, streams, wildlife, agriculture, tourism and water purification plants in our county by enacting proactive regulations to limit the withdrawing of fresh water from lakes and streams and to prohibit throughout our county the transport, disposal, sale or processing of wastewater and brine from horizontally hydro-fracked gas wells; and, in addition, the Council is enacting a citywide ban from any activity that involves the process of hydraulic horizontal fracturing drilling.
