Each activity funded with CDBG monies must meet one of the following three ***National Objectives***: to benefit low- and moderate-income persons; to aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; or to meet the community development needs having a particular urgency. The City anticipates an allocation of approximately \$385,000.00, with up to \$35,000 available for public services.

Eligible activities for CDBG funds include, but are not limited to: Planning; Real Property Acquisition, Rehabilitation, and/or Demolition; Senior Services; Youth Services; Handicapped Services; Fair Housing activities; Employment Training; Neighborhood Cleanups; Housing Counseling; Food Banks; Code Enforcement; Public Facilities (i.e. Streets, Sidewalks, Sewers, Water, Community Centers, Recreation Facilities); Historic Preservation.

CDBG funds can not be used for: Construction of Government Buildings, Political Activities, Lobbying, and Programs that do not meet a National Objective. If you are unsure if your project is eligible, or have any other questions, please contact Lauri Gawronski, CDBG Administrator at (716)366-9878.
