**WHEREAS,** he was a dedicated husband, father, son and Police Officer; and

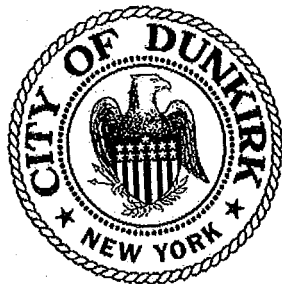
