

## **City of Dunkirk Personnel Committee Meeting**

**November 21, 2016**

**Present:** Chairman Councilman Marty Bomanto, Councilwoman Stacy Szukala, Councilman Don Williams, Councilman Andy Gonzalez, Mayor Rosas, Ryan Hall, Roger Heyden, Vicki Westling, Patty Plezeski.

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Chairman Councilman Bomanto.

### **Ryan Hall's Report:**

- Ryan reported on the ends of both the softball and the flag-football leagues which ended mid-October. Both leagues had no issues and ended with clean seasons. For the flag football leagues, the games were played at both Pangolin field and the High School field.
- Ryan has been in contact with all but one of the elementary schools to get the youth basketball program up and running this year, and only offering the program spots to Dunkirk residence only. It is in Ryan's hopes to conduct the league as it was prior years where the elementary schools played against each other. The league is scheduled to start December 6<sup>th</sup>.
- The Gus Macker Tournament was discussed. It may be unlikely that Dunkirk can do this at least this year. The cost is so high that the only way feasible is to get a corporate sponsor. Williams suggested contacting the owner of the Buffalo Bills. Mayor Rosas said the Rebecca could get a presentation.
- There is a possibility that Dunkirk can run their own type of tournament like a 3/3 that Ryan could over-see.
- The city is still waiting on the contract between the Fair Grounds and the City for the Recreation Center.
- No word on AI Gens and sectionals as of yet.

### **Personnel:**

- There are 5 seasonal employees still working and may be working for about two more weeks.
- There are postings for Deputy Director of Development and Fiscal Affairs Officer. Both positions are posted online and other various places.
- A formal interview was held for the position in the City Clerk's Office. The city is still waiting for the results from the County.
- Still awaiting for official results from Ryan's Civil Service.
