City of Dunkirk calendars for curbside collection of rubbish, recycling, and brush were inserted into newspaper delivery to 2800 residents on January 3. The calendars are two-sided to cover both 2014 and 2015 schedules. Changes from 2013 include an enhanced description for Fall leaf collection to describe that developments in seasonal conditions will dictate the process in the Fall and that citizens will be asked to bag or barrel leaves for quickest pickup when the Fall leaf schedule develops.

In addition to the mass distribution, the City has collection calendars available for walk-in pickup at all offices in City Hall. The Mayor and Director of Public Works encourage citizens to maximize their use of zero-sort recycling on alternate Mondays to help with City environmental sustainability initiatives and to reduce landfill costs.
