

Public Works Committee Meeting- April 10 2012

Present: Michael Michalski, Andy Gonzalez, Tony Gugino, Al Zurawski, Mayor Anthony J. Dolce, Ron Szot, and Stephanie Kiyak.

Meeting was called to order by Andy Gonzalez.

Reading of minutes of preceeding minutes: Andy Gonzalez noted the minutes will be presented at the next meeting.

Reports: Tony Gugino stated he provided a copy of the "tree cut and trim list" of 3-31-12 with a total of 9 cut for month of March. The hot patch plant is not open yet, hopefully it will be open around April 15th, but there has been a crew out doing cold patches, only those in need of immediate attention. Street milling plus patch processing is a total of \$330,000 for the year. Lake front boulevard project is in week 3, they laid the initial water line. Well ahead of schedule due to good weather. Willow brook tank project cleared the lot of trees and brush. Henderson started the big dig, a circle of 12-14ft. Once ready, cement team will be brought in. Andy Gonzalez asked whether or not it was interfering with drivers and Tony Gugino assured him it was not. Also this project got an early jump due to weather. Stephanie Kiyak asked about clean up behind highrise stating it would be good time to start. Tony Gugino stated yes it will be done by Parks Department within the next week.

Al Zurawski said grass notices have started early this year, 3 building demolitions are going along as should be. Mike Michalski asked about some houses near park and second street and Al Zurawski said it was a legal battle at the moment. Violation reports will be provided when his secretary is back from vacation.

Ron Szot spoke in regards to the Garden Policy. He said the application was put together and is in need of sponsorship for the resolution in the upcoming meeting. Each location will be reviewed by Mayor Anthony J. Dolce, Development Director, and City Clerk before anything is accepted.

Mike Michalski asked Tony Gugino if the parking meters could be transferred from the lot out back, out to the front ones that are broken. Tony Gugino stated that the parts are on order and Bruce will be attending to them. Stephanie Kiyak suggested parking passes being used for city employees. It was decided that they would be used and would follow through with a policy on this matter.

Andy Gonzalez brought up the cellphone policy for Stacy Szukala. Ron Szot mentioned the union was provided with a rough draft policy for them to review.

Andy Gonzalez asked about neighborhood watch signs. Tony Gugino was checking into whether or not the designated area was declared a watch area and would be checking into this matter.
